ASSALAMU'ALAIKUM

Charities are allowed to claim gift aid on all donations made by individuals who pay income or capital gains tax without the amount being specified on the declaration form. This will mean that once you have signed a gift aid declaration form, any donations you make to the Worthing Islamic Society in future years will be eligible for gift aid even if the amount changes. If you are a UK tax-payer, kindly complete this form in order that the Society can reclaim from the Inland Revenue, the tax you have paid on your donation.

**Notes:-**

1. Irrespective of your rate of tax, you must pay an amount of income tax and/or capital gains tax at least equal to the tax that the charity reclaims on your donations in the tax year.
2. Please notify the Worthing Islamic Society if you change your name or address while the declaration is still in force.
3. You can cancel the declaration at any time by notifying the Worthing Islamic Society.
4. If you pay tax at the higher rate you can claim further tax relief in your Self Assessment tax return.
5. If in the future your circumstances change and you no longer pay tax on your income and/or capital gains equal to the tax the Worthing Islamic Society reclaims, you need to cancel your declaration.
6. If you are unsure whether your donations qualify for Gift Aid tax relief ask at your local tax office for the leaflet IR 65.
